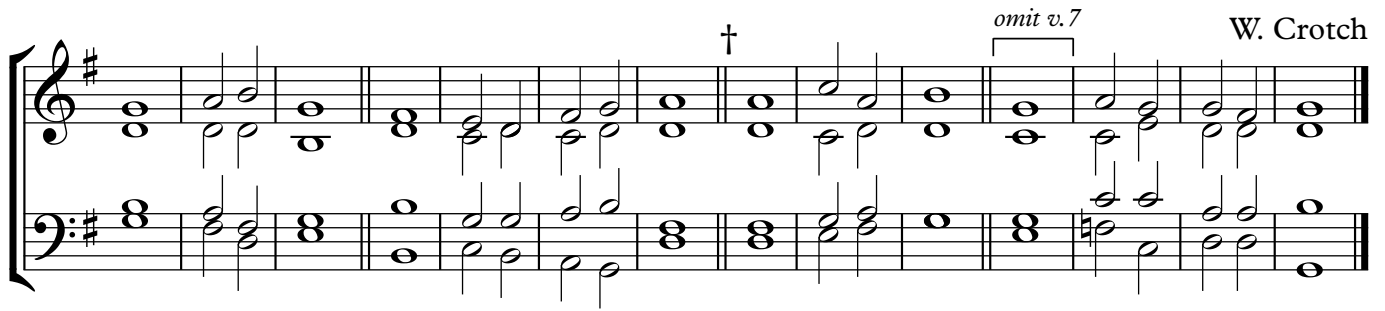


# Psalm 34.1-10
